ROYAL COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS EXAMS - OCTOBER 2020

Newcastle United Football Club re-opened for small meetings and events under the regional covid restrictions.

he first event to be held in the stadium on reopening was held on Tuesday 27th October in the Barracks Suite which was used as a venue for the Royal College of Physicians exams.

Twenty-four students arrived on site, socially distanced and with single file entry. They were greeted by the event organiser who carried out temperature checks and the sign in procedure before the venue sales manager directed them to the suite. Hand sanitising stations were positioned in reception and outside the suite for the examinees.

he exam was split across the Barracks Suite which is the largest event space at the club allowing for plenty of social distancing between desks and to ensure there was no more than 30 people in each area including the invigilators. Bins were positioned in each suite Covid procedures, for examinees to dispose everything felt safe of their rubbish and all and secure personal belongings were kept at the desks.

Catering was provided for the 5 exam invigilators in a separate suite with tea, coffee and cookies and pre-packed lunches. They were socially distanced allowing

for them to safely remove their masks to enjoy the refreshments and relax during their breaks.

Through out the stadium signage has been posted highlighting the importance of keeping

distance and washing and sanitising hands frequently.

At the end of the exam invigilators collected the completed exam papers wearing full PPE and examinees were asked to leave in single file, socially distanced and with hand sanitiser available enroute.
