Fawley Meadows Hospitality Enclosure ~ Covid-19 reassurance ~

Although we've made it to the final step of the roadmap out of lockdown, the safety of our guests and staff to the Fawley Meadows hospitality enclosure remains important to us and we will continue to follow the recommended Government guidance.

To stage this year's Regatta as safely as possible, we have put additional measures in place to reassure guests and provide a safe environment. With this in mind, we kindly ask all guests to the Fawley Meadows hospitality enclosure, aged 11 and older, to show evidence of one of the following:

- **Proof of a negative Lateral Flow Test (LFT)**, reported and demonstrated via your NHS COVID Pass on the NHS app, or a text message or email from NHS Test and Trace. This can be on your device or a printout. The test should be taken within 48 hours of your visit
- Or **proof of full vaccination**, both doses received at least 14 days prior to your visit to the Regatta. It must be demonstrated either via your NHS COVID Pass on the NHS App or the English vaccination letter
- Or, if you're resident in England, **proof of natural immunity**, demonstrated via your NHS COVID Pass on the NHS App

Hand sanitiser will be available across the enclosure and unless medically exempt, face coverings will be required indoors, unless seated at your table.

For peace of mind, all our front of house staff will continue to wear face masks indoors and will be asked to show a negative lateral flow test when arriving at the Fawley Meadows enclosure.

Please do not come to the Regatta if you're feeling unwell.
